Profile of participants: The seminar is open to participants within the field of school education. Participants should have no or little knowledge about KA101-consortium

Themes and goals of the event:

The concept of consortium in School Education was new in 2015. Many NAs agree that they wish they would have more of them. Consortiums allow a larger number of schools to take part in the Erasmus+ program since administration of the projects is no longer a burden for the schools themselves.

Expected results:

This TCA has been run once before, in December 2017 in Norway, and great results have been achieved (most of the participants sent an application that got granted with high ranking in term of score).

Participants will send consortium application to the next KA101-round and will have already started cooperation with receiving schools for job-shadowing.

Cost:

Meals and accommodation: They will be covered by the NA agency: accommodation in a single room for 3 nights, all meals and participation in cultural events.

Travel costs: SEPIE will contribute to the travel costs based on the table provided for TCAs. This financial support will be paid directly to the selected organisation by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website).

Support for accommodation and meals not included in the activity programme: SEPIE will contribute to these costs based on the table provided for TCAs. This financial support (up to 2 travel days) will be paid directly to the selected organisation by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website).

Support for participants with special needs: Applicants with special needs might apply for a reimbursement based on real costs. The reimbursement based on real costs will be granted only if it is clearly justified and requested in the application form, and once approved by the national agency (SEPIE). This financial support will be paid directly to the selected organization by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website). By choosing this option, the participant will renounce to a reimbursement based on unit costs.
